THE 2nd WORKSHOP ON OCEAN ENERGY with a focus on Wave and Ocean Current Energy

The second South African workshop on *Ocean Energy* with a focus on *Wave and Ocean Current Energy* will be held in the Western Cape on **Friday 18 September 2009** at the Skilpadvlei Conference Centre near Stellenbosch. The workshop is hosted by the Centre for Renewable and Sustainable Energy Studies with support from the South African National Energy Research Institute (SANERI).

The aim of the Workshop is to bring together representatives from the private and public sectors to share information on the current state of affairs in South Africa and the world regarding the harvesting of energy from the oceans. The outcome of the Workshop will be a roadmap for the next few years that can guide the development of this industry in South Africa.
