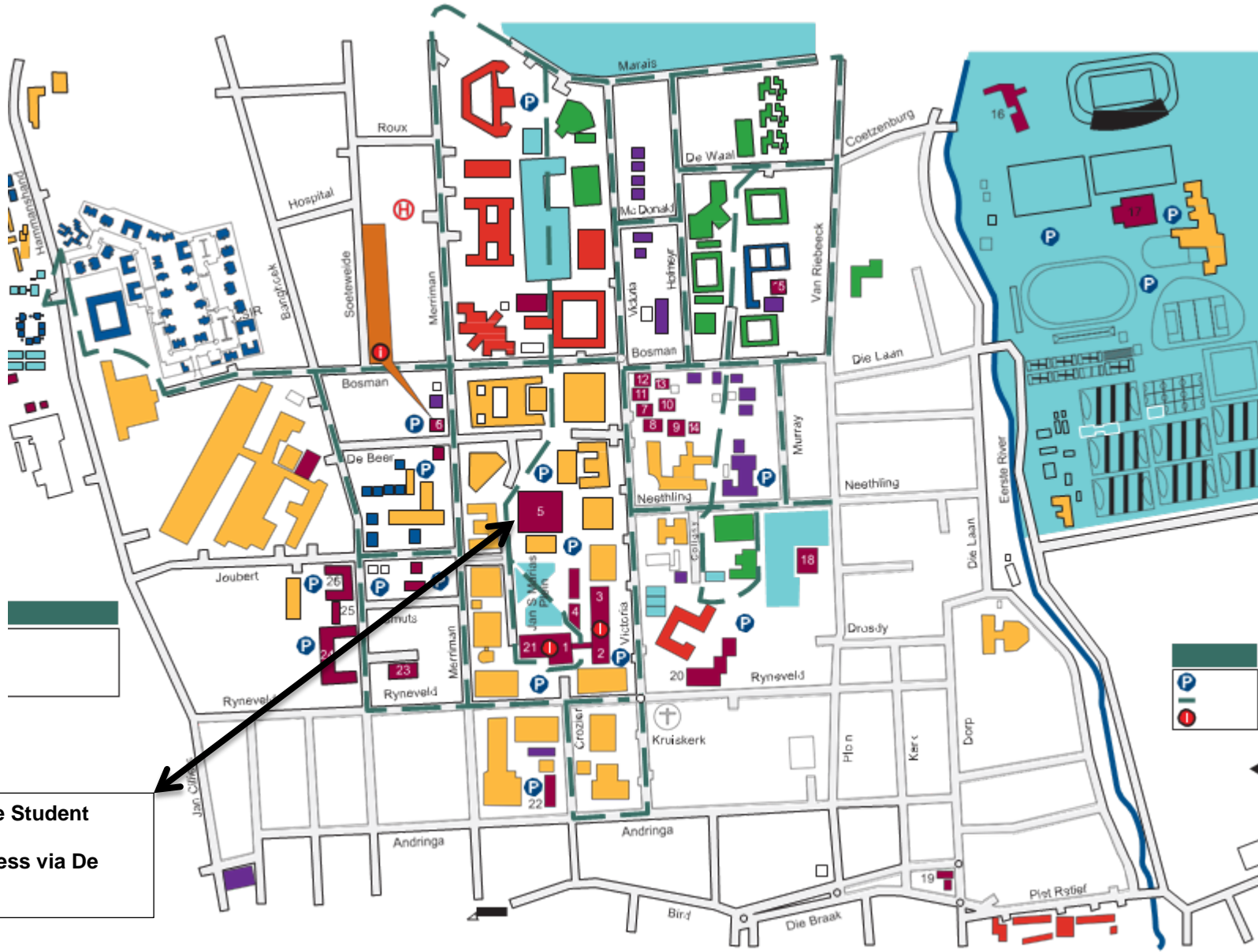
A general discussion on the topic will be facilitated after the presentation.
